2010 CALISTOGA -  
NAPA VALLEY CHARBONO

*These Charbono grapes, estate grown on the Summers' "Villa Andriana" Vineyard in Calistoga grown in deep, loamy, volcanic soil. A very rare varietal, Charbono is thought to have originated between the borders of southeastern France and northwestern Italy. Now only found growing in less than 50 acres of California, Charbono thrives in the northern end of the Napa Valley. A lovely wine of bold color and bright fruit.*
